- 1. 18 years or older**
- 2. Have one or more chronic medical conditions that require medication**
- 3. Availability to meet virtually or in person with a team of 3-4 students *three times during the academic year (1st visit in Sept/Oct; 2nd visit between Dec & Feb; 3rd visit by end of March)***
- 4. Willing to share with the student team your perspective and experience navigating through the health care system with regard to your chronic condition(s)**
