Volunteers Needed for Future Gopher Admit Days 2024

The University of Minnesota Office of Admissions enrolls an academically and diverse undergraduate student body each year. In addition to recruitment and advising, the Office of Admissions also coordinates campus visits and tours for prospective students and families, counsels students through the application and admissions process and provides support as students navigate their way to college.

The Future Gophers Admitted Day Event series is designed to provide an exciting introduction to the University for newly admitted and confirmed freshmen. In addition to a rousing introduction to the University, the program includes collegiate-based activities, campus tours, a resource fair, and opportunities to connect with students, faculty, and alumni in their college of admission.

Details of Volunteer Duties:

Volunteers are needed to assist as greeters and direction providers.

- Volunteers will provide instructions to students and families as they approach event space such as where to proceed in the building and what they will do at check-in tables.
- Volunteers may be outside at some greeting stations to ensure visitors easily move from location to location and have a friendly face to guide them.

Shifts:

- 7:30am 11:30am (morning shift)
- 11:15am 3:15pm (afternoon shift)

Volunteer eligibility and training requirements:

The Office of Admissions is seeking 12 volunteers for each morning shift and 8 volunteers for each afternoon shift. Volunteers are welcome to coordinate registration with a friend and/or to serve multiple shifts and days.

What to wear:

- Silver Gopher Service Corps t-shirts will be available for \$15 at the check-in table each day
- Other maroon and gold colored clothing welcomed
- No competitor gear (e.g. UW Madison, Iowa, etc.)
- Business casual
- Admissions provided name tag

Volunteers' food/beverage availability: Lunch will be provided. Volunteers will be asked about any dietary restrictions.

Parking/Transportation:

<u>UMRA members</u> should use their UMRA membership cards to access the retiree discount rate (the QR code is on the back of the card).

<u>If you are not an UMRA member</u>, you will receive a URVC voucher for parking in one of the on-campus facilities. More information will be provided after registration.
