Sneak Previews offered by the Office of Admissions provide incoming freshman and transfer students a “deep dive” into student life, academic programs and campus resources and tours for prospective students and families.

Volunteers will assist the Office of Admissions in welcoming prospective students and families to campus for a sneak preview into being a Golden Gopher.

Volunteer Duties:

- Provide instructions to students and families as they approach the event space.
- Inform guests where to proceed in the building and guide them to check-in tables.
- Volunteers may be outside at some greeting stations to ensure visitors can easily move from location to location and have a friendly face to guide them.
- Escort families from one campus location to another near Coffman Memorial Union.
- Provide assistance to ensure spaces are prepared for students and families to utilize.
- Help staff with tidying up in between Welcome and after lunch as needed.

There will be a 45-minute break (when students are in sessions) midway through each shift. Volunteers can use this time to take a break and relax.

Location: Check-in for volunteers is in the Great Hall located inside Coffman Memorial Union, 300 Washington Ave SE, Minneapolis, MN 55455.

Volunteers will be assigned to various locations across campus to assist visitors during transitions.

Physical Expectations: Be able to be on campus to greet people either inside or outside. Be able to walk students to designated areas within a two-three block radius.

What to Wear:

- Admissions provided name tag
